

## June 2025 Faith Art Journaling Supplies and Steps

## **Supplies:**

- Journal page (use gesso to prepare the paper if it isn't "mixed media")
- Scribble Sticks, Gelatos, or any non-wax-based art crayons
- Stencils
- Acrylic Paint (four-five colors)
- 2" and 6" paper doilies (save for future embellishments)
- Verse (printed or handwritten)
- Liquitex Acrylic Ink
- Paint brush, blender tools, sponge
- Pieces of mixed media, stamped images for embellishment
- Adhesive

## Directions:

- Prep your journal page with gesso if you are using a sketchbook or anything other than mixed media paper.
- Draw random shapes with one color art crayon and more shapes with second color.
  - (I chose Scribble Sticks in Fuchsia and Blackberry)
- Use the first stencil to apply acrylic paint
  - (Dina Wakley's Cheddar acrylic paint; stencil from Sizzix Studio "Cat Kerr" Collection)
- Apply acrylic paint on second, smaller stencil
  - o (Liquitex Basic Hooker's Green acrylic paint; stencil from Tim Holtz Collection)
- Take a 2" and 6" paper doily and use as stencils
  - (Deco Art Olive Green acrylic paint)
- Apply Deco Art Light Buttermilk acrylic paint to most of white areas.
- Splatter Liquitex Bronze acrylic ink onto page.
- Print out or hand letter verse onto journal page.
- Create embellishment with pieces of mixed media, part of the doily, stamp images.
  - Stamped images from Illustrated Faith, "Fly Free"
