


I'm not Creative


What does it mean to be God's "workmanship"?



Journal Options



Regular Paper Pros

- + "Use what you have"
- + Budget and beginner-friendly
- + Easily available

Regular Paper Cons


- Will not accept wet medium without a gesso application
- Loose leaves need organization

Mixed Media Pros

- + Accepts all kinds of medium without prep
- + Available at most stores like Walmart, Target
- + Spirally bound in a handy-dandy book

Mixed Media Cons

- The Canson small pad (5.5 x 8.5) starts at around \$7.50 and goes up as the size increases



Bible Journal Pros

- + Both the Scripture and art response are on the same page
- + Some include pre-drawn illustrations for coloring

Bible Journal Cons

- The expense and process may be intimidating to beginners



Crafting Your Own Art Journal

Measurements Included Below*



Cover Base

Recycle two covers from a used book that measures 6" wide x 8" long or use chip board cut to size with holes predrilled (add 3 rings).



Paper Covers

Cut cardstock or paper for outer covers and inside covers.* Apply adhesive and adhere. Miter inside corners. Dry.



Choose Page Paper

Go through your stash of scrapbook paper & weed out the sheets bought but never used--be honest, we all have them.



Cut Paper to Size

Trim the 12x12 sheets to 8x12. Fold each in half, to 6x8. Use a bone folder and sand paper to get a nice, crisp edge.

"Signatures"

Group each folded sheet into groups of 3, or a "signature." Six signatures would take 18 sheets of paper (72 journal pages). Add holes to each signature

Embellish the Cover

Use calendar art, textured paper, modeling paste, stencils, paint, 3D letters, stickers, ribbon--really make this journal your own!

*Cardstock or paper for outer covers (2): 8"x10"; inside covers (2) 5.5"x 7.5"






SIMPLE TECHNIQUES THAT BUILD CONFIDENCE



Excitement, energy, passion, desire, speed, strength, power, love, aggression, danger, fire, blood, war, violence, intensity




Blue

Nature, environment, health, good luck, renewal, youth, vigor, spring, generosity, fertility, jealousy, envy




Gray

Joy, happiness, optimism, idealism, imagination, hope, sunshine, summer, gold, cowardice, betrayal, jealousy, covetousness, deceit




Orange

Texture Contrast





hearts, leaves, or circles for accents.






Master Collage

Quick Prompts to Spark Your Page Layouts

A quick, inspirational reference for added texture, depth, and story to your page with simple layers. There's no perfect placement. Just keep layering until that inner creative voice says to stop. Start anywhere—mix, match, and have fun. Print on cardstock and add to a journal pocket.

Module 4

CONNECTING SCRIPTURE AND YOUR CREATIVITY

We began our workshop by reflecting on Scripture--specifically verses where God tells us in no uncertain terms we are each a unique, one-of-a-kind creation. Our perspectives have been shaped by life experiences distinctly our own. God has placed a creative spirit within us, and we can give that spirit a voice through art as a means of worship. In this learning module, we further connect Scripture with our creativity to make faith art journaling a blessing to us while also giving praise and glory to God.

5 easy ways to pick a verse for journaling —

start small. show up. let the Word lead.



1. Pick a Verse You Already Love

Start with a favorite verse you've clung to in the past. If it's helped you before, it will speak again to you--this time in new ways.



2. Use Today's Devotional or Bible Reading

Let your regular quiet time be your creative time. Whatever verse stands out today--use it. Highlight or underline the words that jump out at you as you read.



3. Choose a Situation You're Currently Walking Through

Feeling anxious? Journal a verse about peace. Feeling stuck? Find one about God's guidance. Let your emotional or spiritual condition shape your focus.



4. Let a Worship Song or Hymn Lead You

Listen to a worship song or favorite hymn and write down a line or two that speak to you. Search the Scripture it comes from--you'll be surprised that most do!



5. Use a Prompt or Pre-Chosen Verse

When in doubt, return to your course materials, Google a word or phrase and search for a relevant Scripture, or come over to artnsoulcafe.com for inspiration!

Pause & Pray

Sit with the Scripture. Invite God into your time.



Pick a Verse

Choose a verse, theme, or phrase that moves your heart.



Reflect & Respond

Use Meditation Questions or Journal Prompts to explore personal meaning.



Choose Color & Texture

Let your emotions guide your color choices and background.



Create the Page

Add Scripture, images, layers, textures--simple or detailed.



Close In Worship

Respond in prayer, a blessing, or a word of gratitude for this holy time.

Module 5

BUILDING A GRACE-FILLED CREATIVE PRACTICE
