



## May 2025 Scrapbooking Supplies and Steps

### Supplies Used:

- May 2025 Sketch (downloadable PDF)
- 8"x10" Photo
- 12"x12" 49 & Market "One Perfect Day" Solid Paper Collection (Paper 1) for base
- 49 & Market "One Perfect Day" Tender Moments 12"x12" pattern paper cut 4"x12"
- 49 & Market "One Perfect Day" pattern paper (2 strips 1/2"x12" and 1 piece 1"x3")
- 49 & Market "One Perfect Day" Wildflower Laser Cuts
- Heidi Swapp Monthly "Highlights" Circle Number Stamps (January, February, March)
- Ali Edwards' "Get Real" journaling lines stamp
- Distress Ink "Antique Linen"
- Heidi Swapp Color Collective "Aged" embellishments and Alphabet Stickers
- Heidi Swapp Photo Corners
- Illustrated Faith Die Cut "beautiful"
- 1/4" Double-Sided Adhesive Tape
- Stamp Block
- Adhesive
- Paper Cutter
- Scissors

### 12x12 Page Directions:

- Using a solid 12"x12" cardstock base, adhere 4"x12" journaling strip, and center the 8"x10" photo on page; adhere.
- Adhere 1/2"x12" paper strips to top and bottom of page.
- Apply self-stick photo corners to photo.
- Place title overlapping photo and journaling strip (don't adhere yet—we're just determining position). Mark where "my" and "mother" in alphabet stickers will be placed.
- Add sticker letter words to title. Adhere "beautiful" with adhesive dots.
- Stamp journaling lines and number circles (01, 02, 03) in Antique Linen (I used a scrap of cream cardstock for numbers). Adhere number circles.
- Ink edges of 1"x3" pattern paper with Antique Linen Distress Ink. Adhere with 1/4" double-sided tape

- Select a “bouquet” of flowers from the Wildflower Laser Cuts. Adhere with adhesive squares
- Add embellishments to paper piece.
- Add journaling—what are the three reasons you appreciate/love/remember your mom? Let her know while you still have her
