



## July 2025 12x12 Scrapbook Layout Supplies & Steps

### Supplies:

- 12x12 Cardstock or Patterned Paper base
- Coordinating Paper or Cardstock
- (3) Photos (matted if you prefer on coordinating cardstock)
- Scripture or Journaling (we use John 16:33)
- Washi Tape
- Tim Holtz ephemera
- July Art and Soul Café Printables
- Chipboard Letters for Title
- Subtitle (sticker, stamped saying, or handwritten)
- Adhesive Foam Squares (adds 3D element)
- Tacky Glue/Adhesive
- Optional: Rusty Hinge Distress Ink and Applicator

### Directions:

- Print verse or journaling on 4'x10' coordinating paper or cardstock. (See attached page for instructions); adhere to 12x12 cardstock or patterned paper base.
- Cut a ½" x 11" strip as accent; adhere to larger strip/banner.
- Crop photos to 3" x 3". Matte on cardstock if preferred.
- Adhere three 1" strips of washi tape to top left of banner.
- Prepare the "embellishment cluster" by layering together bits of ephemera, ending with the symbol for peace from this month's printable.
- Embellish the other areas as indicated on the sketch.
- Adhere title made from large cut-out letters, stencil lettering, sticker lettering, or chipboard letters (mine measure 2" tall); adhere subtitle.
- Option: use distress ink to shadow ephemera and title chipboard letters for added depth.

## Directions for Printing

In this month's layout, we print directly onto a coordinating strip of cardstock or patterned paper.

- In MS Word, change Layout ➡ Orientation ➡ Landscape. Insert a text box that measures 4" x 10".
- Insert a second text box at the lower left corner and type your journaling or Scripture verse.
- Print out on regular copy paper to see if it matches your layout.
- Cut coordinating paper to 8.5" x 11" to fit printer—remember to remove text box outline before printing). Trim to 4" x 10".
