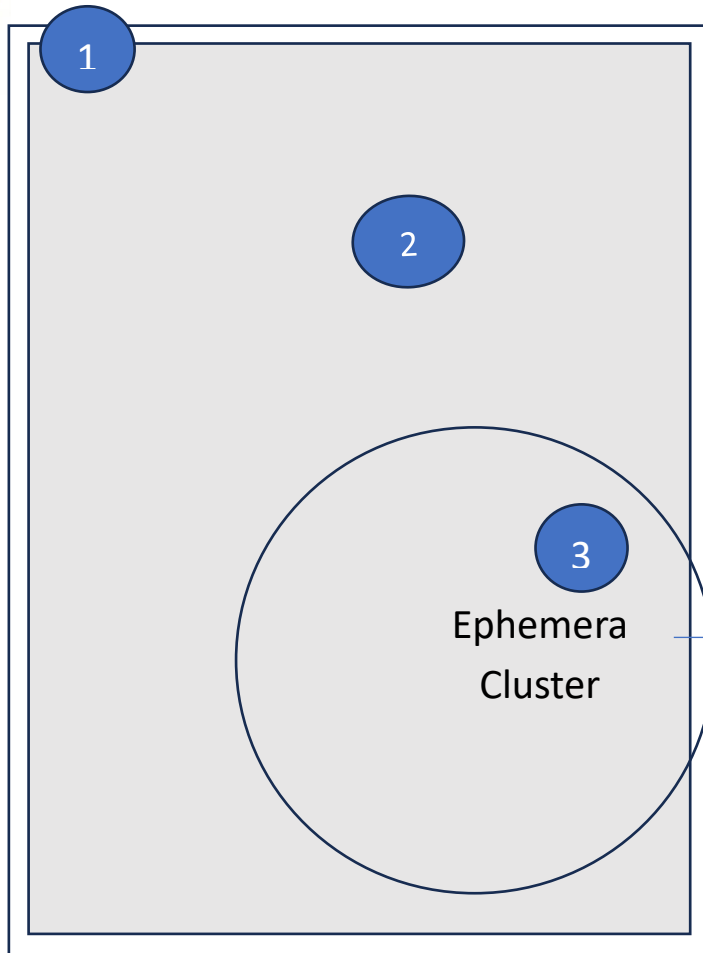




Card Sketch, Supplies and Steps: September 2025



Create Ephemera Layers:

1. Largest die cut creates base (label)
2. Ticket Die Cut
3. Sprig Die Cuts
4. Sentiment (attach with foam squares)

Card Supplies

1. Cardstock and envelope.
2. Mixed Media paper
3. Inks: Dried Marigold and Vintage Photo Distress Inks
4. Stamps: leaves for background (water spritzer optional)
5. Ephemera Cluster products used: Scrapbook.com Sprigs and Nested Sticker Tickets die cuts; Sizzix Tim Holtz Thinlits #665926 Label (cut from pattern paper for contrast)
6. Cardstock for sentiment; printer.
7. Bling (optional)
8. Die Cut Machine (Big Shot)
9. Ink applicators (2)
10. Glossy Accent or Tacky Glue
11. Adhesive
12. Adhesive Foam Squares or Foam Tape

Card Steps

1. Cut sheet of 8.5" x 11" cardstock to 8.5" x 5.5" and fold at 4.25" to make card (lengthwise).
2. Cut piece of mixed media paper to 4" x 5"; apply Dried Marigold Distress Ink to entire piece.
3. Cut another piece of mixed media paper to 4" x 5; apply Vintage Photo Distress Ink to entire piece.
4. Use Vintage Photo paper and cut out sprigs and ticket
5. Cut label die cut out of patterned paper
6. Create cluster:
 - Start with largest piece in back (label), building forward
7. Sentiment printed on cardstock and adhered to top of ephemera cluster with adhesive squares or foam tape.
