

May 2025 Faith Art Journaling Supplies and Steps

Background (Video One)

- Apply **Ranger Distress Inks** (Peeled Paint, Crushed Olive, Wilted Violet, Ripe Persimmon) by swiping over a **stamping block** and spritzing with **water**.
- Add torn a layer of **collage papers** with **PVC glue** and **a paint brush**. My own art papers were scattered randomly over the two-page spread.
- **Two photos** (mine were printed on regular copy paper, 3"x3') trimmed with **water** and torn on all four sides.
- Mix together **acrylic paints** (Golden Titan Green Pale, Liquitex Light Green, and generic Canary Yellow) to create a bright, Spring green.
- Add **baking soda** to the paint until reaching a stencil paste consistency. Apply with **stencil** of choice.

Watch Me Faith Art Journal (Video Two)

- After the first video, I created more white space with generic **white acrylic paint**. I still wasn't happy, so used a wash in **light green watercolor** to fill in. I also removed some of the paint that was applied over the collage paper with **a baby wipe**. Art creates art—there are no mistakes.
- Apply **Distress Oxide** Ripe Persimmon to block from **Studio Calico Adventure Tickets** stamp set.
- Stamp 2 sets of circles in **Distress Oxide Wilted Violet** (the stamps are so old I don't know who to credit them to!) onto **white cardstock**.
- Ink opposite corner edges with **Distress Oxide Rusty Hinge.** Adhere stamped circle cutouts with **PVC glue**.
- Stamp "For This Child I Prayed" using **Ali Edwards' Alphas are Awesome** alphabet onto **clear vellum.** Cut out and adhere to page with **PVC glue.**
- Add a white frame to the focal point photo that has been shaded with Distress Oxide Rusty Hinge.
